No you can only publish the changes. There are exceptions. 1. If you have upgraded your shop from Version 7, 8 or 9 to Version 10 for example, - You must "Publish All" 2. If you have made major changes on your website then it is recommended that you click "Rebuild All" and Publish All

What is a Major Change requiring Publish All? - changing your website theme or making a lot of customization changes (colors, fonts and so on) - when you install new updates which include a lot of fixes. For eg upgrading from 10.23 to 10.24 this would be considered major - if you move to a new server - If you add extra languages to your shop - if you change the URL of your shop, for eg before you published to www.myshop.com/enter.html and now you have changed it to just www.myshop.com - If after publishing your website the display is "wrong" - it appears funny, like an overlapping template and so on. Publish All might fix the issue.

What is a minor Change not requiring Publish All? - adding new Products to your website - changing the prices in your shop - updating Stock Control levels

1. If you have upgraded your shop from Version 7, 8 or 9 to Version 10 for example, - You must "Publish All" 2. If you have made major changes on your website then it is recommended that you click "Rebuild All" and Publish All

What is a Major Change requiring Publish All? - changing your website theme or making a lot of customization changes (colors, fonts and so on) - when you install new updates which include a lot of fixes. For eg upgrading from 10.24 Build 15040 to 10.24 Build 15148 this would be considered major
